24-26/03/2023: ESU holds successful Presidency and Executive Committee meeting in Leuven with focus on current challenges and new care strategy





the living conditions of the Ukrainian people. During the meeting we also paid attention to the new European approach concerning care strategy, welcoming Colin Scicluna to support their discussion and approval of a long-prepared resolution on "The New European Care Strategy." The EPP Political Assembly of September 2023 will put it on the agenda.

The ESU-meeting in Leuven also looked ahead to the busy and important years of 2023 and 2024 at different political levels. Finally, delegates left with warm words of appreciation and thanks, new insights, strong solidarity, and the conviction that together, they have an active role to play in tomorrow's Europe across generations.
